There is a little "girl" who sits in her wheelchair and bobs her head over and over back and forth uncontrollably. It makes anyone with the slightest bit of compassion feel their heart break watching them enjoy what little they can. They don't know what the outside world is, and they don't need a million dollar building with strangers looking after them. They are the ones who are being shuttled off to a home which makes no difference to them but all the difference to those that love them in spite of their afflictions. They just need their home, which is part of SDC.
